Saturday, Feb 25	Hökūloa (Venus) 3° south of the Moon
Monday, Feb 27	Ka'āwela (Jupiter) 4° south of the Moon



February 2012 Highlights

Mercury is in the western sky after sunset the last week of the month.

Venus will be visible for about 2 hours after the sun sets. Look for it near the Moon on February 25th.

Mars rises around 8 pm in the East. Look for it high overhead at midnight.

Jupiter is visible in Pisces. Look for it in the southwest at sunset..

Saturn rises around midnight in the Eastern sky and is visible in Virgo.
